The Director, Indian Institute of Petroleum, on behalf of the sponsor of projects, is interested to engage Project Assistants for various time-bound projects in different schemes as per the details given below:-

A. FOR SUPR A INSTITUTIONAL PROJECTS:

Project Assistants engaged under Eleventh Five Year Plan in “Supra Institutional Projects”, are eligible for the following benefits:

- Higher start may be considered in the case of candidates who have cleared at least CSIR-UGC lectureship (NET) or GATE (minimum score-85 percentile) examination. In such cases consolidated emoluments may be fixed after adding 10% to the fixed consolidated emoluments.
- Project Assistants are eligible for yearly increment of 10% of their consolidated emoluments based on their annual performance.
- Project Assistants engaged at Level-II and above level will be entitled for TA/DA as per JRF, SRF and RA respectively while on official tour.

B. FOR CONTRACT RESEARCH/SPONSORED PROJECTS:

General Conditions:

- The facility of Ph. D registration shall be allowed to those Project Assistants who have worked for minimum period of two years and have at least cleared CSIR-UGC lectureship (NET) or GATE examination or published 2 papers in international peer review ISI indexed journals. However, at any given time not more than 30% of Project Assistants shall be allowed to register for Ph.D.
- The engagement will be initially for a period of six months, which may be extended or curtailed depending on the duration of the sponsored project/desired level performance or conduct of the incumbent, as the case may be. The maximum duration, for which Project Assistants could be engaged in different projects taken together in IIP/CSIR Laboratories, will be for a period of 5 years. The performance of the Project Assistant would be reviewed periodically (half yearly) so that any one not found up to the mark, could be terminated or replaced.

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3. Engagement will be co-terminus with the project. All these positions are **temporary** and are **not** IIP/CSIR appointment and will not confer any right on the incumbent to any claim, implicit or explicit on any post in IIP/CSIR.
4. There would be no automatic shifting of Project Assistant from one project another. On completion of the tenure in one project, in case, one wants to apply for engagement in another project, he/she will have to go through the process of selection by submitting a fresh application under the new project. Engagement of the Project Assistant under the new project would be made only after submission of "No Demand Certificate" and 'No Dues Certificate' in the previous project and submission of resignation from the previous project.
5. Depending on the availability, hostel or single room accommodation facility may be extended to the Project Assistant subject to the provision of CSIR allotment rules, modified from time to time. Deduction of license fee would be as per CSIR rules.
6. The Project Assistant shall be permitted to avail leave as per the existing rule.
7. The Institute may also provide canteen/staff bus facilities as is being provided for regular staff members on payment of sitable charges.
8. Final semester and results awaited candidates will not be allowed to appear for Walk-In-Interview.
9. Age limit: 18-28 year. Upper age limit is relaxable by 5 yrs for SC/ST and 3 yrs for OBC candidates. Relaxation in age limit to PWD (Physically handicapped) candidates shall also be provided, as per the Government of India rules.
10. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview and reporting for duty.

Note: Eligible and interested Indian National **candidates may appear for Walk-in-Interview on the date, time and venue/address as mentioned above** alongwith the duly filled in application form, which may be download from the Institute website [www. iip.res.in](http://www.iip.res.in) supported by one set of attested copies of certificates regarding (i) educational qualification, (ii) age, (iii) category (in case of SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates), (iv) one latest passport size photograph, (v) experience certificate, if any; and (vi) detail biodata etc.

Original certificates are required for verification, which would be returned immediately on the same day after verification. Candidates have option to reply in Hindi during the interview. The panel may be prepared for future requirements, if any, for up-coming projects. Canvassing in any form will be treated as disqualification for the positions.
