Number and capacity of burette assemblies and Electrodes for respective measurement

Reply 1: The Instrument should be Advanced Potentiometric Automatic Titrator should be capable for analysis of low level of Mercaptan Sulfur in petroleum products and instrument should be capable of performing other titrations like acid-base, non-aqueous, redox and precipitation for which electrodes, burette and other accessories may be procured as and when required.

Burette Volume: 50 ml - One quantity with specifications shown below as mentioned in the specifications:

1. Burette resolution: 1 micro liter or better. Burette assembly to support titrant AgNO3.

2. Equipped with burette auto fill and auto emptying facility with single command

3. Equipped with the auto read and write facility and also to detect burette volume to store all relevant information related with burette

Burette dead volume should be zero after flushing
System should have provision for nitrogen flushing in titration

6. Electrode should be sensitive and capable of measuring low level of mercaptans - 2 Nos with auto calibration facility of the sensors.
