1.1.4 Functions and duties :**Organization**

CSIR-Indian Institute of Petroleum is one of the premier institutes of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, (CSIR) and is accredited with ISO 9001:2000 certification. CSIR-IIP provides Research and Development as well as technical support to the hydrocarbon industry. It develops and transfers technologies to industry, in the area of petroleum refining, natural gas, petrochemicals, chemicals and utilization of petroleum products. It provides technical services to the industry, imparts training to the personnel of the related industry, assists BIS in formulation of standards for petroleum products and conducts techno-economic feasibility studies & market demand surveys of petroleum products. It plays an important role in assisting refineries in absorption, adaptation and selection of technologies and in optimization of unit operations. It was established in 14th April 1960 to provide technical and scientific support to the entry of public sector in the hydrocarbon industry at that time. Initially from 1962-66, it had technical collaboration with Francais du Petrole (IFP) France. The Institute has its vast campus amidst lush green tea gardens in the foothills of Garhwal Himalayas, at Dehradun. It has been functioning in this campus since April 1963. The Institute has qualified, experienced and dedicated staff of R & D scientists and skilled technical personnel. Detailed information is available at its website www.iip.res.in.

- **Resource Base**

CSIR-IIP has a strong resource base- both in terms of scientific staff and financial resources. Presently the strength of Scientists and Technical Officer is 145. The institute has strengthened its financial base through external earnings of Rs. 1304.59 lakhs in year 2023-24 and Rs. 1747.73 in year 2024-25 and 1993.97 in the year 2025-2026 during the last three years which speaks volumes about the faith the industry has put in the Institute. In the period 2023-26, 472 Research Papers were published in SCI Journals. Thirty-eight (Indian and Foreign) patents were filed and 33 patents (Indian and Foreign) were granted. Fifty-two Doctoral theses were awarded by AcSIR in the last three years based on the research work conducted in the Institute.

- **R&D Infrastructure**

CSIR-IIP has a strong infrastructure support for R&D activities and state-of-the-art facilities for analysis, evaluation and testing of crude oil, petroleum products, chemicals and catalysts. Facilities include well equipped laboratories, computer-controlled pilot plants and micro-reactor units for catalyst and process development, multipurpose fully automated pressure swing adsorption unit, biotechnological research facilities, lubrication testing facilities, advanced analytical facilities like NMR, FT-IR, SEM, TEM, GC, GC-MS, rheometer, TGA, etc., short-path molecular distillation system, software for computer simulation & modeling and computer networking. Engine testing laboratory is equipped with chassis dynamometer for HDC vehicles and cars. CFR engines for MON & RON, automatic exhaust emission analyser, MPFI testing and dilution tunnel for particulate measurement. The Institute has a workshop for designing and fabrication of metallic and glass equipments, captive power generation and its own water supply system.

- **Core competence**

CSIR-IIP's core competence encompasses diverse aspects of R&D in the downstream sector of petroleum industry as listed below:

- ✓ Crude evaluation and physicochemical characterization of petroleum products
- ✓ Catalyst and conversion processes
- ✓ Separation processes
- ✓ IC engine studies including emissions and alternative fuels studies
- ✓ Industrial and domestic combustion
- ✓ Tribological studies
- ✓ Process development for petrochemicals and intermediates and for biocatalytic processes
- ✓ Development of additives and specialty chemicals for hydrocarbon sector

- ✓ Molecular level characterization of petroleum products and related products
- ✓ Simulation, modeling and process design
- ✓ Bio fuels
- ✓ Waste valorization (waste plastic, refinery waste, residual biomass)
- ✓ Gas hydrates
- ✓ Petroleum rheology and flow assurance

- **Major Processes & Products Developed and Commercialized**

The Institute follows a consortium approach for development of its technologies and for providing the total engineering package to its clients. Most of the R & D projects have industrial partners in development.

CSIR-IIP has been providing competitive and sustainable technologies and products to meet the requirements of the ever growing energy sector. Over the years, CSIR-IIP has developed a large number of Technologies/Processes/Products, and several of them have been commercialized against global competition. Almost every refinery in the country has technologies licensed from CSIR-IIP. Almost every refinery in the country has either a technology, product or knowledge resource from the Institute.

- **Technical Assistance**

Technical assistance and consultancy is provided to oil companies on various refining operation and related activities. Analytical tests and chemical analysis by state-of-the-art equipment and performance evaluation of petroleum products are also taken up. Lubricating oil, additives fuel, fuel saving additives and devices are evaluated by field trials. Testing and evaluation of fuels and oils for emission type approval, octane / cetane rating of gasoline/diesel fuel and rating of engine components is provided. Emission evaluation of power generator sets for COP testing, and testing of smoke measuring equipments is also taken up.

- **Training**

The Institute conducts specialized training programmes for technical personnel from refineries, petrochemical plants, automotive industry and power plants. These programmes are designed as per specific requirements. Faculty is mostly drawn from the Institute itself but is supplemented with experts in specific areas invited from other organizations. On an average more than 16 programmes are presently conducted per year. So far 1188 personnel from various industries have been trained at CSIR-IIP. It would not be an exaggeration to say today in the Indian hydrocarbon industry there is hardly any person who has not had his training and knowledge brush-up at the CSIR-IIP.

As part of skill India programme, CSIR-IIP has conducted 26 skill development programmes since 2022-2026 and trained about 353 participants

- **Awards and Recognitions**

The Institute and its scientists have received many prestigious awards in recognition of excellence in various fields. CSIR-IIP has the distinction of bagging many CSIR Technology Awards in the last several years. CSIR-IIP has received TDB National Award and ICC, FICCI, ICMA, NRDC Awards for its technologies.

CSIR-IIP is a member of various National bodies and is recognized by many Indian Universities and academic institutions to conduct research leading to award of Master and Doctorate Degrees. The scientists of the Institute are members on the editorial boards of reputed International and National Journals. Universities invite the eminent scientists of the Institute as guest faculty and external examiners.

- **International Linkages**

CSIR-IIP has moved towards globalization of its products technologies. CSIR-IIP's products are also accepted by refineries abroad. It has forged alliance with several prestigious international organizations.

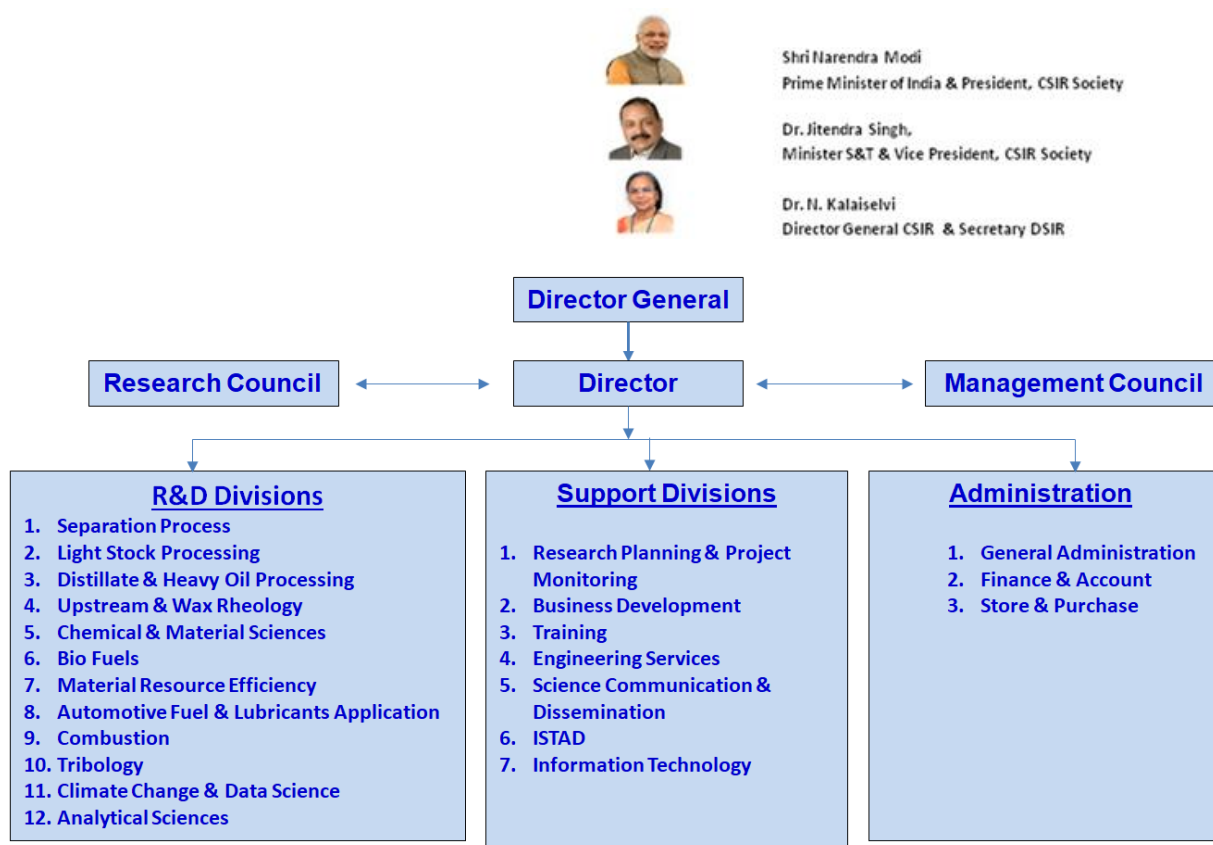
- **Transfer of CSIR-IIP Technologies**

Within the scope of the license of CSIR-IIP process, which grants the right to use CSIR-IIP's know-how, CSIR-IIP ensures the supply of all required technical documentation, full training of licensees personnel in CSIR-IIP's facilities, all necessary assistance for the start-up of the licensee's plant and the disclosure of all future improvements of the CSIR-IIP process as and when required.

- **The Road Ahead**

CSIR-IIP is recognized as (a) a technology provider of national importance in refining, petrochemicals, lubricants, bio-energy and process energy efficiency solutions and (b) a consulting knowledge bank, training and skill development provider for these sectors to support their growth, profitability, productivity, sustainability and competitiveness. Our focus on Domestic Carbon Utilization to replace imports of energy and chemicals, and Decarbonization to replace Fossil Energy, has sharpened in recent years. Internationally benchmarked value addition ("Crude-toChemicals") to low-value refinery streams like Bottoms and Naphtha, crude to chemicals, Biofuels, conversion of carbonaceous wastes (biomass, plastics) to fuels and value-added products, and decentralized and hybrid energy solutions – notably for Rural India – all fall within the scope.

Regarding R&D activities, we have Heads of Divisions who normally take a decision in process making in consultation with the Director. The individual scientists report to the HoDs through HoAs. The HoDs are accountable to the Director who in turn reports to DG, CSIR. Research council advises and guides the institute in R&D activities. In administration, we have three wings namely, Administration, Finance & Accounts and Stores and Purchase. All the three wings are headed by Controller of Administration, Controller of F&A and Controller of S&P respectively and directly report to the Director. In addition, various internal committees have been constituted which are bestowed with specific responsibilities to address problems of specific in nature. These committees give their commendations to the Director who would take a final decision. The Director is also the final decision maker in all policy related issues. As mentioned above the final authority in the decision making process rests with the Director and in certain specified matters, the final authority rests with DG, CSIR, as per the Rules, regulations and bye-laws. However, certain powers have been delegated to lower functionaries by the Director. We are guided in our activities by our Controlling Authority, i.e. CSIR. Based on its directives, the decisions are taken at Laboratory level by the Head of the Laboratory, i.e. Director.

Dear Director/Head,

Sub.: Initial Allocations for the F.Y. 2025-26

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that for the 2nd consecutive year, CSIR has achieved the distinction of being the only Central Autonomous body to generate & sign the Balance Sheet on 01st April through the AMS software. The unstinted co-operation and support from you and your team has enabled CSIR to accomplish this challenging task.

2. However, the experiential learning from the issue areas of the last F.Y. should serve as a guide so that the same mistakes are avoided in future. Accordingly, while communicating the initial Budgetary allocation of your Lab/Instt./Unit (copy enclosed-Annexure-I) under GIA-Salaries, GIA-General and GIA-Capital for the current financial year 2025-26, I am sharing certain issues & challenge areas which require suitable corrective/remedial measures to avoid their recurrence.

3. **Pace of Expenditure:** It is a matter of concern that inspite of instructions, regular monitoring by Central Budget Division/ Central Planning Division during Monthly Utilization Monitoring meetings, the pace of expenditure particularly under GIA-Capital was slower than expected which was not a desirable position. As per extant orders, more than 33% expenditure should not be incurred in the last quarter of the financial year with a ceiling of 15% in the last month (March). It is, therefore, imperative to adhere to the aforesaid limits by respective Labs /Instts/ Units to avoid any issue in this matter.

4. **Non-adherence to time limit for intimation of Surrender / Savings:** It has been observed during closing of financial year 2024-25 that certain Labs/Instts/Units continued to intimate surrenders / savings till the last days of March 2025 in contravention to DG CSIRs' instructions circulated vide JS&FA letter No. 42-4(4)/ERP/Accts/2021 dated 01.01.2025 which had fixed 31st January, 2025 as the last date for intimating the same. This caused considerable issues in budgetary management and utilization of Govt. grant funds in the last F.Y. It was also observed that some labs while surrendering the Cash / Assignments did not surrender the related allocations which led to avoidable confusion at CSIR Hqrs. In order to avoid a repetition of this situation in the current financial year 2025-26, I would request you to instruct all the concerned functionaries to plan the activities in such a way that all the surrenders / savings, if any, are intimated to CSIR Hqrs not later than 31st January 2026. Any surrender / savings intimated after the aforesaid date would force CSIR to consider applying budget cut in the next financial year.

5. **Opening of Letter of Credits (LC's):** Extant orders/instructions contained in GFR, 2017 and issued by CSIR may be adhered to and matching of record of Lab/Instt/Unit with the record of the Bank may be ensured.

6. **Outstanding Items of OB & BR:** While a significant progress has been made in clearance of OB and BR, some of the Labs /Instts/Units have still not been able to settle the outstanding OB & BR up to 31st March 2024. It is critical that the momentum gained is not lost due to lack of efforts in this area. May I, therefore, request you to kindly instruct all the functionaries i.e. Stores & Purchase, Gen. Administration, PME, ESD & others to provide requisite support to Finance & Accounts division to settle all these outstanding items at the earliest.

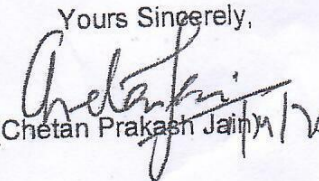

I would also like to take this opportunity to inform you that component-wise assignment from TSA will be transferred proportionate to the budget allocation and due caution may be exercised to ensure that expenditure under all budget heads is booked by utilizing assignment only from the corresponding GIA component in TSA.

8. It may also be ensured that the allocated funds are utilized in accordance with the relevant rules/orders/manuals/guidelines/instructions etc. issued from time to time by CSIR/Govt. of India.

9. Allocations under Projects, Works & Services etc. shall be processed shortly and communicated after approval of the Competent Authority

10. Looking forward to your continued support, co-operation and requisite action in the areas outlined above.
